Optional Items: Coffee mug, beer (glass containers are not allowed) or anything you would like to drink other than water, a bottle for water during the day, snacks, folding chair, pillow / cot or air mattress, bug spray, flashlight, fishing equipment (& WI license), pocket knife, soap / toiletries, rosary / favorite prayer book, rain gear, water shoes, sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, towel, etc.
